Thanks to the Sanborn Auxiliary for the Fall Luncheon & Style Show. The money raised allows the Auxiliary to do so many special things for Sanborn.

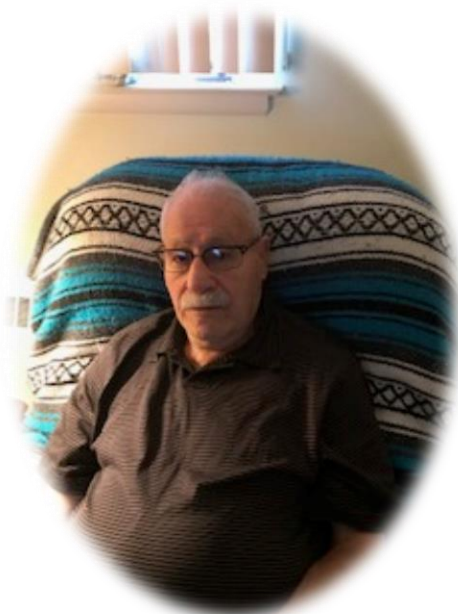


Thanks to Chemical Bank for volunteering on Columbus Day. The volunteers finished some necessary yard work. The yard looks beautiful.

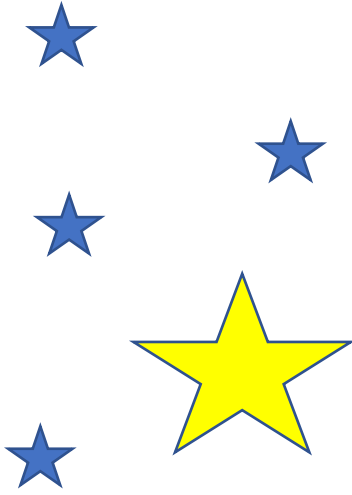
